Smith is the author of Buffalo River Country and the Buffalo River Handbook, two publications that played a crucial role in achieving the Buffalo's designation as a National River. Smith has dedicated his life to advocacy on behalf of the Buffalo, devoting countless hours to building trails and promoting conservation of the river. He co-authored the first master plan for development and use of the Buffalo National River. He was formerly a civil engineer and park planner for the National Park Service from 1962 to 1974 and education director for The Ozark Society from 1974 to 1977. More recently, Smith has worked as a freelance writer, photographer, and researcher and is a board member emeritus for the Buffalo River Foundation.
